Admissions Process, Tuition, Fees, and Contact Information

The admissions process:

- Attend an information night or an open house presentation (meet the teachers, learn about the curriculum, arrange for a optional tour during the school day, ask questions)
- Optional tour during the school day
- Submit application forms and non-refundable fee (\$35.00) by April 19th and ensure that copies of school records and a teacher/adult recommendation have been sent to Oasis
- Parent visit (half-day, after application is complete)
- Student visit (half-day, after parent visit)
- Interview and/or assessment of student and family with one of the teachers

Tuition and Fees:	\$35	nonrefundable one-time application fee, due with application
	\$300	nonrefundable one-time registration fee for new students, due with signed enrollment contract
	\$200	assessment fee for new students, if assessment is requested by parents or teachers during the admission process
	\$250	annual materials fee, due with July tuition payment
	\$6900	yearly tuition, payable in 12 monthly installments of \$575/month, starting in June , due by the 10 th of each month
